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
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Open Evening

Brand New Recycling Scheme

20th – 26th September was National Recycling Week, a chance to encourage and remind everyone about the importance of recycling. We know environmental concerns are still on the increase, so we need to do more and we need to do it now. Recycling is something everyone can do. It was the perfect opportunity for us to remind students, staff, parents/carers and the community about the recycling schemes we have in place at Northgate and about one new scheme in particular. We are now a collection point for a Terracycle scheme, in partnership with Warburtons, which recycles not just any brand of bread bag, but also other items such as plastic from tea cakes, crumpets, wraps and more.

Bags of items can be dropped off at our reception, or students can put in the boxes in the main hall or pass directly to Miss Theobald in MA6. Alternatively, these can be put in the crisp packet collection box in Morrisons or Nationwide Building Society in Dereham.

We are proud that we can help recycle these items into new plastic items – over 170Kg of writing instruments and 230Kg of crisp packets have

been recycled so far, raising almost £500 for Cancer Research UK – AMAZING!
