

# INTO Film Club at Northgate

INTO Film is a National Lottery funded scheme run in partnership with the British Film Institute, providing an online platform where school children can engage with many different aspects of film. From being able to stream hundreds of film titles (old and new) to adding reviews, taking

part in competitions and learning from film makers – pupils who are enrolled into the online club can gain exclusive free access to all of these fantastic things.

The main part of the club is of course the weekly film screenings. These take place each week for Year 9 - 11 students in EN6 with Mrs K Smith (Film studies course leader and English teacher). So far, we have watched Dear Evan Hansen and Attack the Block. After half term, we are going with a horror theme, seeing as pupils return to school on Halloween!

To gauge pupil interest and find out what films you want to see, we have

uploaded a Google form to Satchel for students in Years 9 – 11 to complete. We are always looking for new members so please do complete the form and sign up outside EN6 if you fancy joining. Note that you will need parental consent to watch some of these films due to the age rating.

In addition (do not feel left out Years 7 and 8), Mrs Gill runs a Cinemaniacs film club in the library every Thursday 3.15pm – 4.15pm.
