



Are you succeeding? How do you know? Regularly assessing; to and evaluating your progress is a vital part of the learning cycle. Feedback is not always marking.

THE POMODORO TECHNIQUE

- 1. Know when it is due
- 2. Find somewhere quiet without any distractions
- 3. Music and Study Buddy videos in the background can help keep you calm and focused.
- 4. Make sure you read the task properly before you start your homework.
- 5. 'Done is better than perfect'!







Academic Transition

Academic transition - as important as social transition

We use: -

- information from your school
- SATs results
- Baseline Tests (start of September)
- Accelerated Reader

We do not set by ability in Year 7 (except Maths)

Research shows it benefits all learners







Sets, Form Groups and Houses

Teaching Set = the set you will be in for lessons.

Form/Tutor Group = your form group who you meet with once a day.

House = your House (Attenborough, Rowling, Holmes or Hawking) - linked to House Competitions and Sporting Competitions



Standards and Outcomes

Some students find the jump to Key Stage three is big!

We consistently track progress and intervene if we recognise an issue

Literacy and Numeracy intervention programmes run throughout our Key Stage 3 programme, eg: -

- phonics intervention with our Literacy Librarian
- •small group Maths work with our HLTAs.







Reporting Progress

Year 7 parents evening (face to face) at start of November

Individual teachers will get in touch throughout the year if they want to praise your child's work and/or if they are concerned

You will receive three reports throughout the year. We call these Assessment Point 1 (Autumn) 2 (Spring) and 3 (Summer)

Clear snapshot of your child's progress that term in each subject. Every teacher reports on progress and attitude to learning







Reporting Progress

Once a year, you will receive a full set of written reports from each of your subjects/teachers.

When we report on progress, this is individual to your child and their starting points when they joined us. We know every learner is an individual and we are interested in their personal progress.

When they enter Year 10 and 11 at GCSEs, progress will be reported to you as a forecast grade.



Systems and Routines

Your first point of contact will be your child's form tutor, preferably via email. Email addresses of tutors will be available on the school website in the summer term.

Your child's form tutor is also their first point of contact e.g. for forgotten kit. Students see their tutor daily.

Please remember that tutors teach across all years, including A Level; they will respond within a minimum of 72 hours.

Systems and Routines

Urgent/emergency contact must be to the school office.

Appointments must be made in advance if you wish to speak to a member of staff in person. This can be done by contacting the tutor directly or via the school office.





One Way System and Social Areas

All children follow a one way system around school.

Each year group has its own social area (playground), locker area and toilet block.

Year7 form tutors are on duty daily to help and support students.

Year 7 will also have the support of the Year 11 prefect team at break and lunchtime.

Medical support

Your child must go to reception to be assessed by our first aid trained staff.

We will assess them and contact you if appropriate. If they contact you directly we cannot look after them properly.

If your child has a specific medical condition that needs an adaption to the day or normal school rules, please contact the Heads of Year to discuss this further.







Attitude to Learning at Northgate

The Attitude to Learning policy is available on the school website.

If your child shows positive attributes in class they will receive merits:

- These can be checked in SIMS parent app
- Merits can be exchanged for items in the rewards catalogue

If there are negative incidents your child will receive a detention in line with our C Codes and policy:

- These can be checked in SIMS parent app
- Detentions in school are either C2 <15mins or C3 <30mins

Attendance

To put this into perspective:-

83.3% of pupils who have over 95% attendance achieve grades 9-4 in English and Maths (DfE research)


90% = 19 days absence in the year

90% over 5 years is 19 weeks absence or 1.5 terms (half a year)


95% = 9.5 days absence in the year

95% over 5 years is 9.5 weeks absence or just over half a term




