Science Live 2025 Disneyland Paris.

Dear parents/carers.

We are extremely pleased and excited that for the first time Northgate High School will be experiencing Science Live in 2025, taking place in Disneyland Paris. This trip is open to children currently in years 8 and 9, who will be starting their GCSE's in 2025 and we are delighted to be able to offer pupils an exciting opportunity to see how the science curriculum at GCSE fits with everyday lives. Study themes will be based around physics, chemistry, maths and sustainability during the conference with a closer look at rollercoasters and pyrotechnics, the use of senses when designing experiences, planning of parks and waste management. This trip is most suitable for pupils who have a love of science or wish to find careers in science or engineering. There will be plenty of opportunities for riding the roller coasters and exploring both of the Disneyland parks and all they have to offer, including fantastic light and firework displays, immersive events and the magic of Disney.

The trip will take place and leave early morning on **2nd March 2025** and return to Northgate High School late evening on **5th March 2025**. The cost of the trip has been subsidised by the Dudgeon Fund and we ask for a contribution of £687 per pupil. The cost includes all travel and channel crossings, 3 nights bed and breakfast in Hotel Disneyland Paris, transport to and from Disneyland Paris, entry to both parks on 2 days, and travel insurance. Pupils will be required to provide means to purchase their own food on the days of travel and they may wish to buy food and souvenirs at Disneyland.

Pupils will need a valid passport and a UK Health Insurance Card (GHIC) and details of those documents will need to be provided prior to the trip on Parent Pay. If you need to apply for a GHIC for your child please use the link https://services.nhsbsa.nhs.uk/cra/start. We will be issuing more details about the trip and the requirements for pupils nearer the time.

If you would like your child to join us on this event, please secure their place by paying an initial £75 deposit on Parent Pay and giving your consent by 16th May 2024. Spaces are limited, due to the size and capacity of the coach and will be available on a first come basis.
